- Partnership Engagement working with West Yorkshire Police, the Wakefield Children Vulnerable to Exploitation (CVE) team, Children & Young People's Services, Schools & Colleges, Parents, Carers and Volunatary & Community organisations will create a coordinated and effective response to child exploitation in the Wakefield District.

Key Messages

Multi-agency working is essential in keeping a child safe from exploitation

Raising awareness of the teams involved in identifying and stopping Child Expoitation locally

Any child, including those who are vulnerable can be exploited in any context

Be professionally curious about the typical 'stereotypes' of victims and perpetrators and the language you use

Objectives of the campaign



- To support a child in order to prevent, identify, disrupt and stop child exploitation
- To increase awareness of the signs and indicators of child exploitation
- To encourage a child centred response to child exploitation, recognising that children may commit crime as part of their exploitation
- To increase the reporting of intelligence related to child exploitation

Exploitation in the Wakefield District



Children are being groomed, exploited and abused. Some of the ways in which perpetrators are adapting their tactics to avoid detection include:

- An increase in online grooming into criminal exploitation and sexual abuse
- · An increase in children being groomed into county lines
- An increase in the use of girls to carry weapons or sell drugs as they can often go unseen
- An increase in Technology Assisted Child Sexual Abuse (TACSA) and Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM) including deep fake, Al generated images/videos

As practitioners, we need to be alert to changes in models of exploitation and share any new trends or patterns appropriately, and adapt our approaches and responses continually
