What services will do next

- Share my knowledge with the rest of the team and remain vigilant for spotting any warning signs
- Confidence to speak with CYP about how they can become victims and the ways this can occur. Advising them to Don't pay, block them, not to panic and feel they can talk to someone about this- they're not to blame.
- Be more relationship focused with children who may be vulnerable
- Sharing with colleagues incorporating information on WF-I-Can website to raise awareness with c&yw we have recently added online transactions in to the Risk & Resilience Framework so will look to include links to support and resources for practitioners on there
- Sharing possible signs & indicators
- Raising awareness of sexual financial exploitation across partnership workforce and further developing resources where there are gaps.
